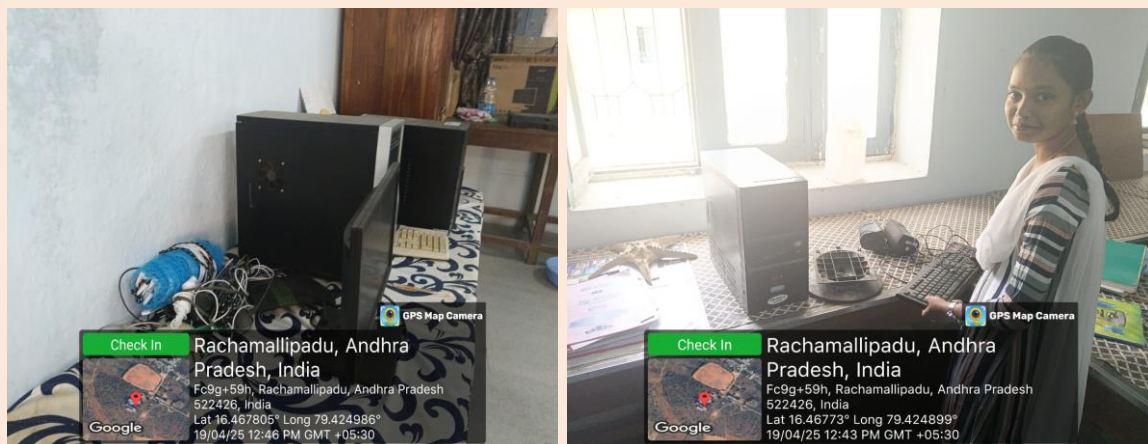
## Swachh Andhra

As part of the **Swachh Andhra** initiative, **SKBR Government Degree College, Macherla**, organized an **E-Waste Management Drive** on 19<sup>th</sup> April, 2025 in the college premises to promote awareness and responsible disposal of electronic waste among students and staff.

The program aimed to educate the college community about the hazards of improper e-waste disposal and the importance of recycling and sustainable practices. Under the guidance of the Principal, **Dr. J. Lakshmi Kumari**, the college took up the initiative to collect and safely dispose of outdated and non-functional electronic devices such as old computers, printers, mobile phones, and other electronic peripherals.

A special awareness session was conducted where faculty members explained the environmental and health impacts of e-waste and the need for eco-friendly practices. The initiative concluded with a

pledge by all participants to **reduce, reuse, and recycle e-waste** and to spread awareness in their communities.



### Land to Lab Programme

The Department of Chemistry organized a two-day workshop "Land to Lab" program in association with Aries Agro Ltd. on 25th and 26th April, 2025. The event was presided over by Principal Dr. J. Lakshmi Kumari.

Sri A. Venu Gopal Reddy, Assistant Zonal Manager, and Sri V. Anji Reddy, Senior Officer from Aries Agro Ltd., attended the program and demonstrated various pests affecting crops. They also provided valuable insights into pest management techniques.

As part of this program, students were trained in conducting soil tests to determine the types and properties of soil, as well as the availability of essential nutrients like Nitrogen, Phosphorus, and Potassium, which are crucial for crop growth.

Sri G. Amarayya and his team members (from Piduguralla) participated in the event and highlighted that the excessive use of chemical fertilizers is leading to the depletion of soil fertility and a consequent reduction in crop yields. To address this issue, they emphasized that their organization's mission is to select students through internships and train them to create awareness among farmers by offering appropriate advice and suggestions. A total of 19 students participated and benefitted from this program.

Dr. Y. Vyshnavi, Lecturer in Chemistry, and Sri G. Rajashekar, Lecturer in Zoology, also actively participated in the event.
