International Webinar on RPA with AGENTIC AI

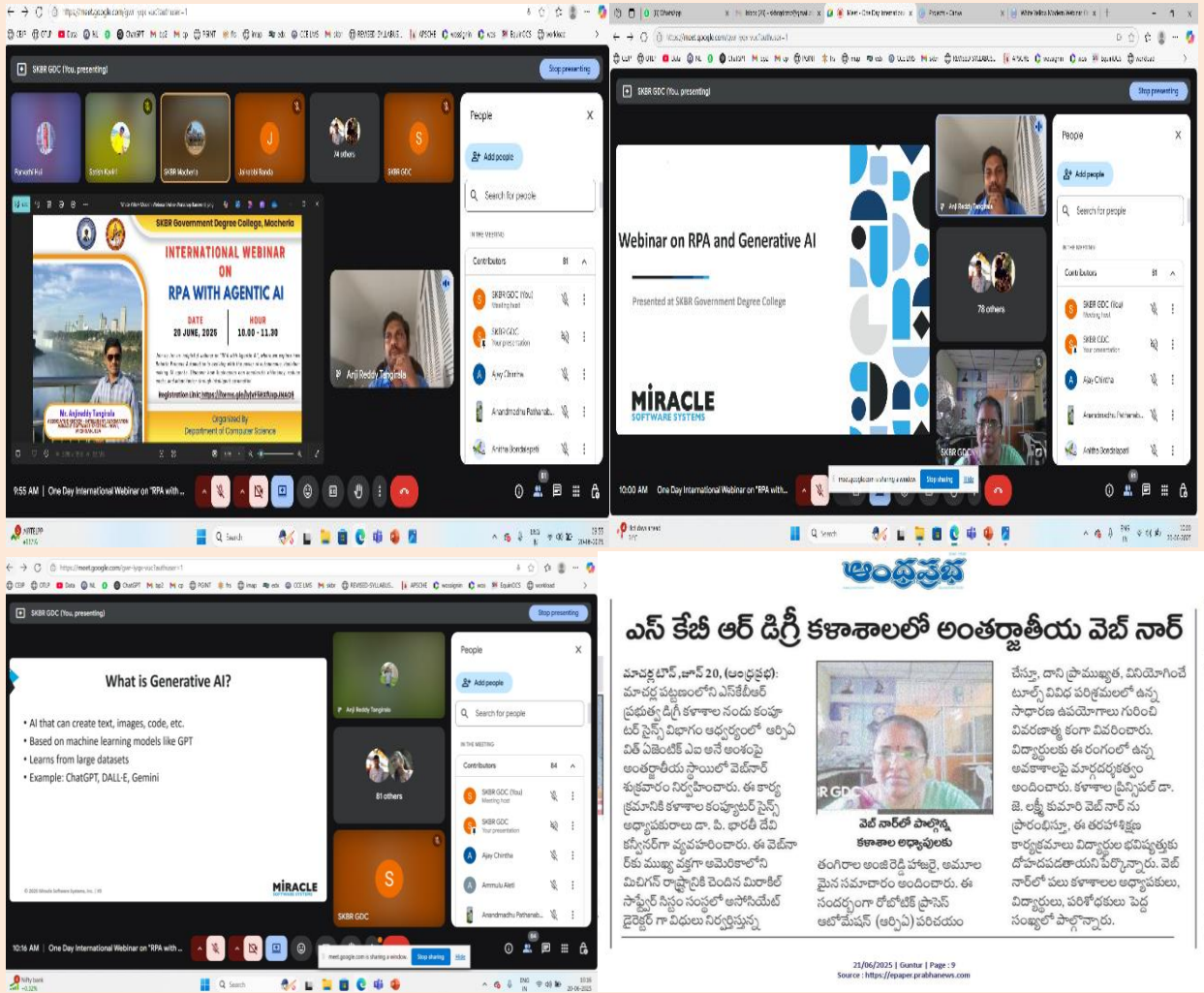

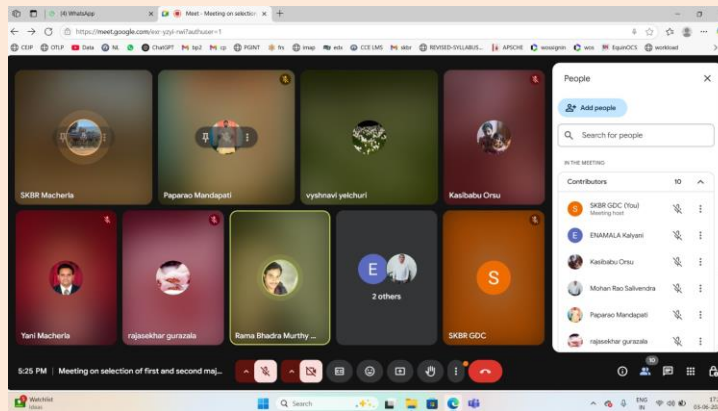

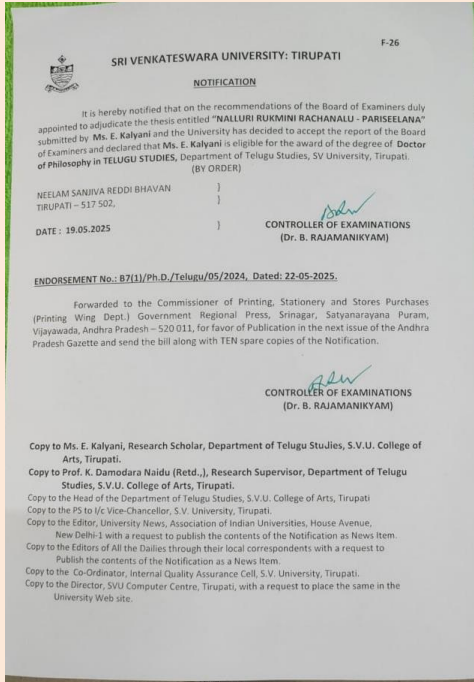
