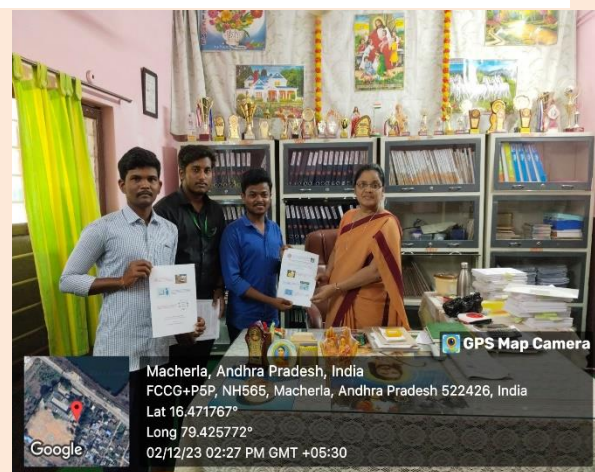

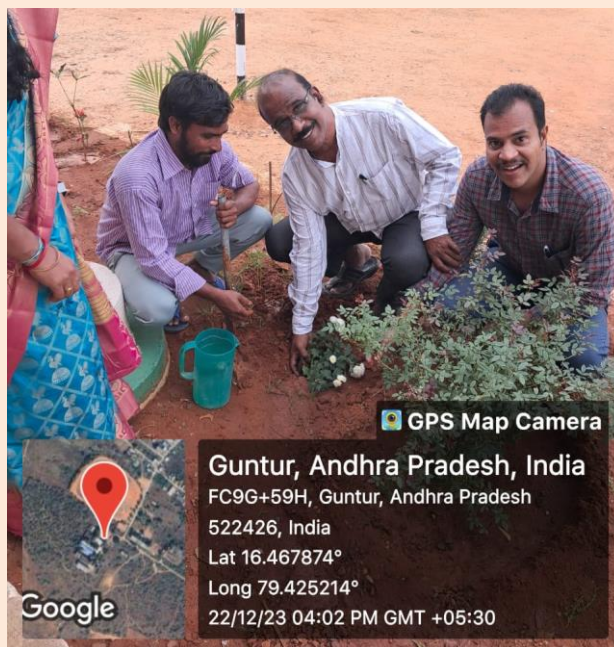

Best Practice

As part of Bestpractice, the department of botany done an activity with the help of students which is Solid waste management and Kitchen waste management. The Botany Department has implemented a systematic approach to handle solid waste generated within the college. Proper segregation bins have been strategically placed across the premises, clearly marked for different types of waste - recyclable, non-recyclable, and hazardous waste. This initiative aims to minimize the environmental impact of waste disposal and encourages responsible waste management practices among students and staff.

The department has established composting units on the college premises to process organic waste generated from the cafeteria and other kitchen facilities. This includes vegetable peels, fruit scraps, and other organic matter.

The composting process is carefully monitored to ensure optimal conditions for decomposition. The resulting nutrient-rich compost is then utilized as a natural fertilizer for the plants across the campus. This closed-loop system not only reduces the volume of waste sent to landfills but also contributes to the enrichment of the college's greenery.

The implementation of these waste management practices has had several positive outcomes. It has fostered a sense of environmental responsibility among students and staff, creating a cleaner and more sustainable college environment. Additionally, the use of compost as a natural fertilizer has enhanced the health and vitality of the campus plants.

After 30 to 40 days the solid waste was converted to compost.

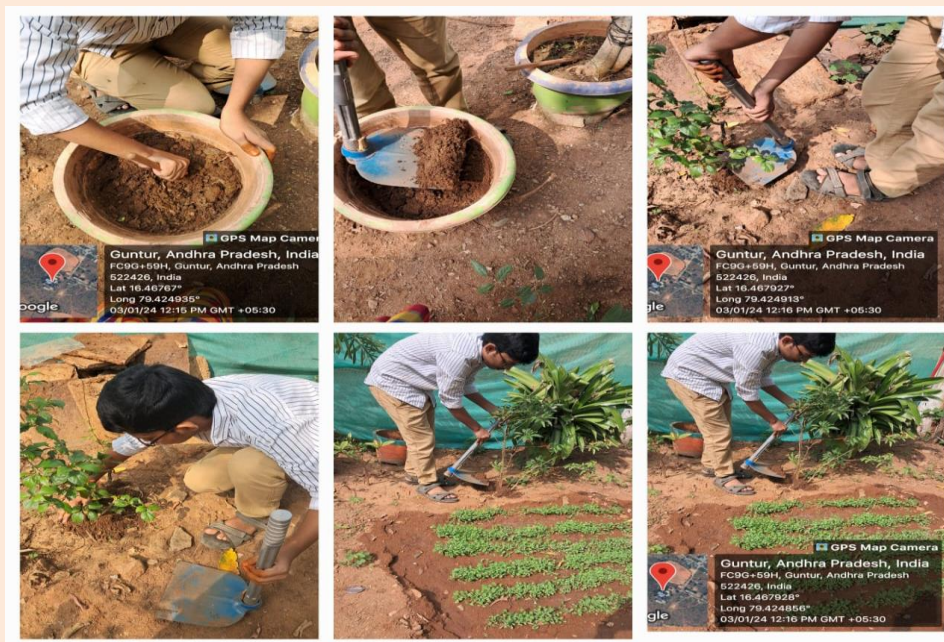
Glimpses Kitchen Waste Management



- ✚ Kitchen waste collected and kept in a pot which contain soil .
- ✚ Covered the pot with polythene sheet which is impermeable to water and soil.
- ✚ This condition is necessary for decomposers present in the soil.
- ✚ After 10 days the kitchen waste converted to compost.
- ✚ Compost is a mixture of ingredients used as plant fertilizer and to improve soils physical,chemical and biological properties.
